The Fischer Carr Scholarship Fund



Skip Carr and Jim Fischer were very good friends and very active civic and community leaders. They touched many lives and were best friends to many people. When Jim Fischer passed away, a Scholarship Fund was organized by the St. Petersburg Kiwanis Club in order to perpetuate his legacy of community service. And when Skip Carr died, it was only appropriate to add his name to the fund to also perpetuate his legacy of service.

The Club has joined with the City of St. Petersburg's St. Pete's Promise and the Pinellas Education Foundation's "Take Stock in Children" Program to provide free college tuition to deserving students. Students are selected from Grades 6-12 and are assigned a mentor. They have been qualified and selected by the Pinellas Education Foundation based upon financial need, good grades and attendance. If they maintain that status through graduation from high school, they will receive free college tuition. Since 2004, our Club has provided scholarships for 330 students, many of whom could never have envisioned attending college at all.
